

#### KIDICAL MASS DEMANDS 2021



Safe school cycling networks by 2030

**School streets and traffic-calmed areas** in front of schools and nurseries/ kindergartens

**Steady annual funding** with concrete targets for the municipalities

**Child-friendly road traffic laws** with Vision Zero as the highest premise

- a speed limit of 30 km/h in built-up areas
- protected and structurally separated, wide cycle paths on main roads
- play streets and residential areas without through traffic.

#### Closer exchange and networking

Idea: setting up signal groups on different topics. Pre-defined rules are important (netiquette)

#### KIDICAL MASS



If you want to change something, you have to start with the children!



We are not (just) cute...
...we are the mobility revolution!



#### **Target group**

- Young people and all children who can already cycle themselves
- Families with babies and toddlers on seats, in trailers and cargo bikes.
- Running bike also possible for fit kids, best with "back-up" in case they "give up": change to bike seat, trailer or cargo bike (communication rather passive because of running wheels)
- The whole family incl. grandma and grandpa, friends
- "Familiy and friends": People without (small) children in their lives are also welcome to join the ride

#### Registration as protest/demonstration (Germany specific)

- For the protection of children
- Also legally, children under 8 years of age are not allowed to ride on the road as they do at the Critical Mass
- Advertising for demonstrations usually only after at least 48 hours after registration (state-specific
- Possibility to make concrete political demands, to have banners with you
- Template for demo registration also for hygiene concept Corona is provided in the cloud folder
- Route can be chosen freely, inform authorities in advance usually no restrictions



#### Route length/speed

- 5 8 km in other cities, sometimes breaks are included for street painting with chalk and ball games
- In Cologne between 6 8 km, we do not communicate the route in advance (only shortly before the start via Facebook and CM APP for latecomers), as many parents do not trust their children with the route
- Even the 3-4-year-olds manage it without any problems
- Alternatively, plan a route to shorten in hot or rainy weather and coordinate with the police
- Speed approx. 8 12 km/h depending on the width of the roads (and the number of participants)

#### Date and time

- Saturday or Sunday (very dependent on local structures, time very individual)
- Sunday, typical excursion day, Saturday, on the other hand, classic weekly shopping day
- Saturday, can lead to more attention depending on the city
- Afternoon, less stressful for families (relaxation Sunday morning and nap time for small children)



#### Start and end of the ride

- You'll need to start somewhere a few people on bikes/trikes can gather.
- It's nice to end your ride in a place where there's lots of space, so people can park their bikes and chat. Space to have a picnic and for children to run around is also important! If you can, get people to bring cake, cake makes everyone smile:)
- Possible destinations: playground, park, community centre, etc., important
- In Cologne: changing destinations to reach as many people as possible. Common end with picnic for chat (leads to greater bonding and creation of further multipliers), sometimes highlights such as crêpe/waffle/ice-cream bike or concert (not a must-have!)

#### Welcome

- Greeting as well as possible short speeches with demands with soundbike and microphone
- List safety-relevant things: Parents are responsible for children, follow instructions of stewards, always leave 1 1.5 m space on the left/right for corkers/stewards or as an emergency lane, reference to photos and videos in the context of a public event, the group stays together and those following also drive at red lights (important for children)
- Optional: point out the "children's block" = children who drive at the front of the demo without



#### Safety

- Mostly police cars in the front and back, always an experience for the children too
- Ask about e-cars in your city
- Often police motorbikes for securing intersections and major roads
- In Cologne: Round table with command, complete bike squad (12 people), avoid police motorbikes as safety risk when using pavements
- Corkers as marshals from CM circles for side protection, closing gaps, road closures, etc,
- The ratio of marshals to participants is determined individually for each city/state.
- No event liability at a meeting ("demo" is not an "event")
- Important: Closing speech on arrival at the destination, official end of the demo, reference to a common end after the demo (this means that it is not an event at the destination, the task of the police is also finished)
- Possibly have a paramedic or volunteer doctor on the bike (not a requirement)



#### Promote the ride (communication)

- Personal contact with families with flyers, posters and multipliers (cycle shops, schools, day-care centres, cafés, events, etc.), primarily in the vicinity of the starting point and above all the destination.
- City and family magazines, calendar of events
- Invite local media and send press release in advance
- Website (if necessary, provide posters and flyers for self-printing / "promo kit")
- Email distribution list and Messenger service Initiatives/associations/parents
- Social media, good for networking, but personal contact remains most important

#### **Supporters/Alliance**

• Find suitable (cycling/mobility/sustainability) initiatives, networks and associations to support (financially, materially and/or for communication)



#### **Orga-Team**

- Get a few people together who can help you organise the ride, because it will be good to get some help and other people also bring in new perspectives. You don't need any prior experience, just enjoy cycling ©
- In the cities very different: partly private persons, members of cycling/mobility/enviornmental initiatives
- Team Cologne consists of private persons (5 pers.) with and without children = good for different perspectives, partly active in associations like ADFC (local group of German cycling association)
- Advantageous/important: at least one team member with children, as even more "lifeblood" and suitable perspective flows into the matter
- No political parties

#### **Orga effort**

- Very variable, if only demo registration, search for organisers + destination with picnic: very low.
   Then flyer distribution is the biggest effort, but can be done well with 2 3 people,
- During the demo, corkers/ stewards are needed according to the number of participants



#### **Capture the event**

Try to get a (semi-)professional photographer or videographer to capture the ride, as well as friends and supporters to take photos and videos with their phones. The friends and supporters footage will be useful to post during or very soon after the ride, to tell people about the ride and how successful it was. Make sure you ask the photographer/videographer if and how they'd like to be credited.



#### Finances/ Budget

- For flyers and posters (sustainable printers are usually not much more expensive).
- If necessary for other activities or highlights, e.g. ice cream/waffles on a donation basis, games/craft activities, stickers, "parking ticket action" see Frankfurt
- Good experience with donation box and on-site appeal

#### **Politics**

- Invitation of city representatives (politicians and city administration) to a direct exchange with the families and, if necessary, to present/state concrete demands
- Ensure that there is no party politics and that the families' point of view is taken into account
- In Cologne: Team "bicycle representative" as well as district mayors of starting points and destinations.

## ASSESSMENT FROM TRAFFIC ADVOCATE OF THE ADFC (BICYCLE FEDERATION OF GERMANY)



The Kidical Mass is not an event, it's a political demonstration.

For a demonstration no costs must be caused to the registration, so that every person can exercise his democratic right.

On the topic of liability.

There is always (at least) one parent present. In this case, the organizing organization has not assumed any supervisory responsibility for the children. As is usual in public road traffic, this is the responsibility of the parents.

It is not sufficient for liability that someone has come to harm, e.g. through a fall or collision. Nor is mere causation sufficient (without the Kidical Mass, the child would have stayed home and not fallen). Liability requires fault in the form of intent or negligence, with few legal exceptions.


It can be negligent to prepare the Kidical Mass as an organizer inadequately (no registration as a meeting, selection of unsuitable streets, no/too few/badly prepared stewards). This would then be a violation of the traffic safety obligation, especially if this would also overburden the accompanying parents. I can hardly imagine that with a proven format like the Kidical Mass. The organizing organization or other associations are not liable for the misconduct of impatient drivers. In this case, the car driver or owner would even be liable for the operating risk of his motor vehicle without fault. In addition, children under the age of ten are generally not liable for accidents with motor vehicles.

Thus you do not need insurance. But of course you should look at this again with the right to demonstrate in your country.





#### SCHOOL STREET ACTIONS



Temporary ban on motor vehicles passing through one or more streets in the vicinity of a school at the beginning (and also) at the end of the school day

Two actions in Cologne 2021 : Weiden (film) & Ehrenfeld (press)

Accompanying project day/week on mobility education

Both school streets approved by politicians as traffic trials for 2022: <u>BV Lindenthal</u> & <u>BV Ehrenfeld</u> ...and another decision on a school street by <u>BV Mülheim</u> (BI Sicher durch Dünnwald)







Scaling Germany-wide, but also Europewide network Basis for school cycle path network
